Administration & Implementation

- Ensure that cash assistance programs like the guaranteed income pilots in the City of Chicago and Cook County do not count as income on beneficiaries' taxes to maximize their intended benefit
- Monitor the impact of City of Chicago and Cook County guaranteed income pilot programs and coordinate on evaluation and expansion
- Monitor the impact of the City of Chicago Fair Workweek Ordinance and consider plans to expand at the state level in Fiscal Year 2024 (FY 2024)



Legislation

- Advocate for the passage of paid family and medical leave (PFML), as well as paid sick time without preemption
- Advocate for the creation of a state child tax credit
- Enact HB 4423, amending the Illinois Public Aid
 Code to reduce the proportion of child support retained by the Illinois Department of Human Services
 (IDHS) and increase the amount of child support that children actually receive from their noncustodial
 parents, alleviating family poverty and strengthening parent-child bonds

for Women, Infants and Children (WIC), conducted by the Greater Chicago Food Depository
